
Sixth Form Homework Guidance



At Christleton Sixth Form we follow a 60 for 60 approach to learning.



All students in Sixth Form can expect to **study for 60 minutes (1 hour) outside of every 60 minutes (1 hour) lesson** that they attend.

For each subject, this equates to 9 hours of study/homework outside of subject lessons.

Students can expect this to take the form of teacher set tasks, independent learning, consolidation of knowledge and revision for assessments. During Learning Habits lessons, students will be supported in learning how to plan their time effectively, how to use subject specifications and how to revise effectively.

EPQ and Maths Studies class teachers will also set homework to support in class learning.

• During NEA/Coursework completion windows, students should use their allocated homework time to focus on individually chosen aspects of their work.
