

# Year 7 Homework Guidance



Year 7 students follow a structured homework timetable to support distribution of tasks and to gradually prepare students for later years of study. The information provided below offers more detail on what students can expect during their first year at Christleton High School.

Now we have reach the Spring Term, Modern Foreign Languages, Science, History and Geography subject teachers will now start to set homework for Year 7 once (twice for MFL) per fortnight following a homework timetable (below). Teachers of PE, Art, ICT, Design Technology, Religious Education and Performing Arts will set tasks as and when appropriate, to suit the needs of the curriculum. The homework timetable below will be used for the remainder of the Year 7 school year.

Each homework task should take students 30 minutes to complete, on average.

As a school we hold the importance of reading as a priority. We encourage all students across all years to read for 20 minutes a day. This could be at home or in iResearch during break, lunch or after-school.

Classteachers will set homework during the Spring Term for Year 7 on the days outlined below. In exceptional circumstances (e.g staff absence) homework may be set outside of the schedule below. All homework can be accessed via Synergy.
