Year 8 & 9 Homework Guidance



Students in Years 8 and 9 will be set homework according to curriculum time allocated to each subject.

As a school we hold the importance of reading as a priority. We encourage all students across all years to read for 20 minutes a day. This could be at home or in iResearch during break, lunch or after-school.

The table below indicates the suggested amount of home learning per subject.

Year 8 and 9 Subject	Time duration
Maths	60 minutes per fortnight
English	60 minutes per fortnight
Science	60 minutes per fortnight
History	30 minutes per fortnight
Geography	30 minutes per fortnight
MFL	30 minutes per fortnight
ICT	30 minutes per fortnight
PE	30 minutes every half term
RE	30 minutes every half term
Art	30 minutes per fortnight
DT	30 minutes per fortnight
Music	30 minutes per fortnight
Drama	30 minutes per term
Literacy/Reading expectation	20 minutes every day
Daily expectation	30-45 minutes a day + reading

Additional Notes

- Key Stage 4 class teachers will decide upon the day that classes will be issued homework. This will be explained and advertised to students clearly. However, staff may set work outside of set days to suit the subject Curriculum Map.
- During NEA/Coursework completion windows, students should use their allocated homework time to focus on individually chosen aspects of their work.
