Volunteers required for Covid-19 testing from 8th-22nd March inclusive

In relation to my email and information regarding the return to school for all students during week commencing 8th March, we are in need of volunteers to help with the Covid-19 testing process.

As you know, we have been testing staff and students who are currently attending school and the process has worked well; the tests are simple to use, and the test subjects swab themselves, with a trained person supervising them, producing a result in around 30 minutes.

The role of the volunteer will be that of Processor, and full training will be provided.

Processors explain and assist test subjects on how to perform the self-administered test, handle and process the swab once the test has been completed, and keep their processing area clean. Testing and sampling procedures are carried out in line with required quality standards, and these are strictly maintained. Full PPE is worn throughout the process; NHS test and trace training will be provided.
